1. Introduction of Nursery Classes (Bal Vatika 1 : Age 3+)

We are planning to install these panels in the remaining classrooms as well in the due course.

4. Introduction of Robotics and Artificial Intelligence (Classes I to IX)

SCHOOL FEES

All the parents who have not cleared the pending dues of their ward are requested to do so at the earliest. Owing to the increased expenditure and rising costs, the school management has decided to increase the school fees for the academic session 2026-27. The fee increase has been implemented strictly within the permissible limits granted by the Government and in accordance with the prescribed norms and regulations applicable on an annual basis. We are trying to provide our children with good infrastructure and to ensure that they receive the highest quality of education in our school. Hence, the increase in the fees is imperative. The Parents have been provided with the option of paying the school fee on a monthly (before 10th of every month, except for the 4th quarter), quarterly (by the last date of the first month of that particular quarter. That is, 30th April, 31st July, 31st October and 31st January) or on annual basis (by 30th April, 2026). However, according to the option chosen, late fee will be charged after the last date of fee payment. We urge all parents to pay the school fees on time.

The academic session 2025-26 has been an enriching one for all our students and we are sure that with your whole-hearted support and co-operation we will be able to give our students a good learning environment and the right set of values that will hold them in good stead all throughout their lives.
