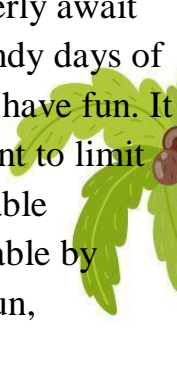

Please take note:

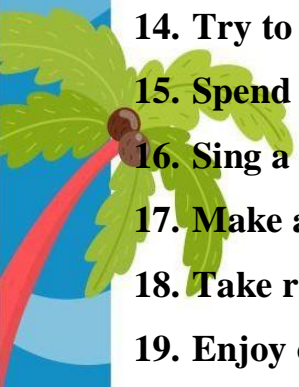
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- Prepare a systematic timetable and follow it religiously from the very first day.

 - Help your child make an attractive handmade folder with Pastel sheet Decorate it and compile all the homework in it.
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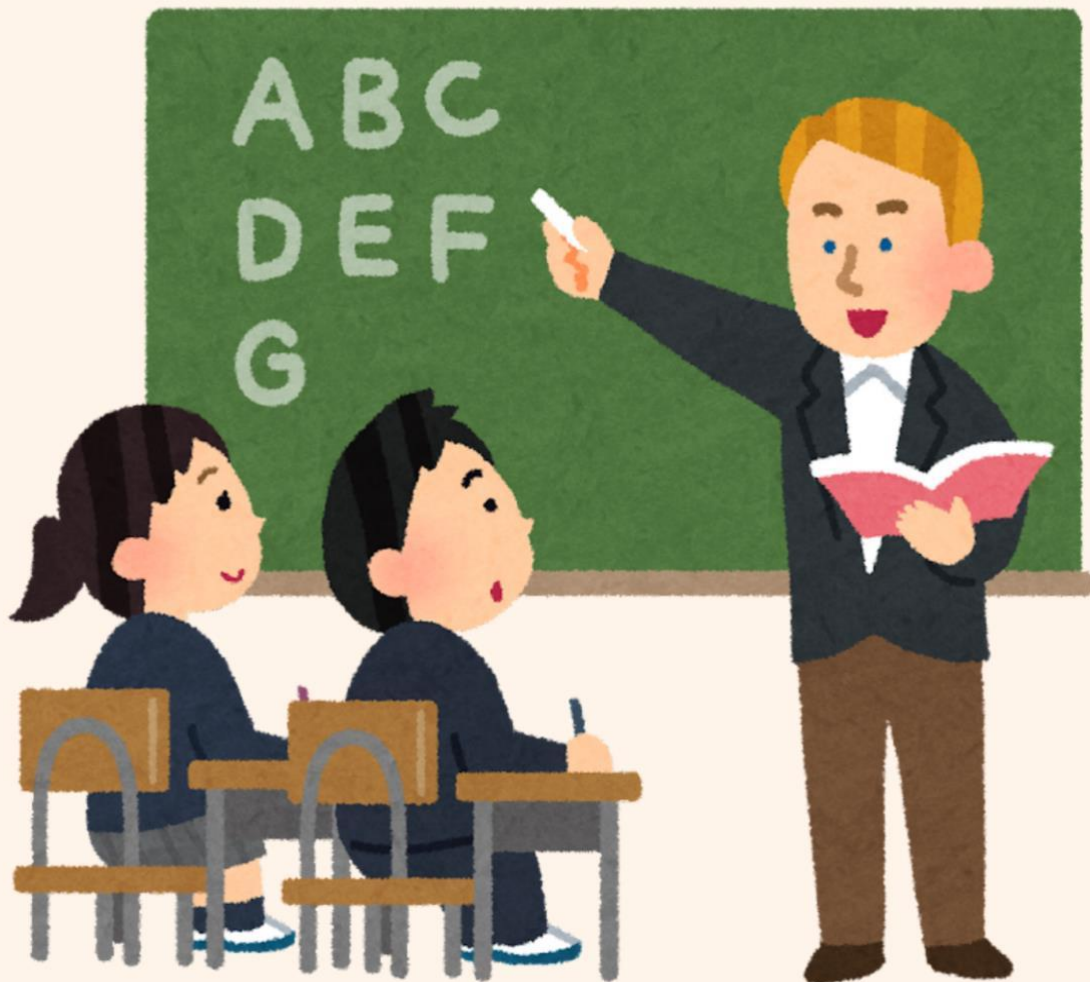
Summer BUCKET LIST

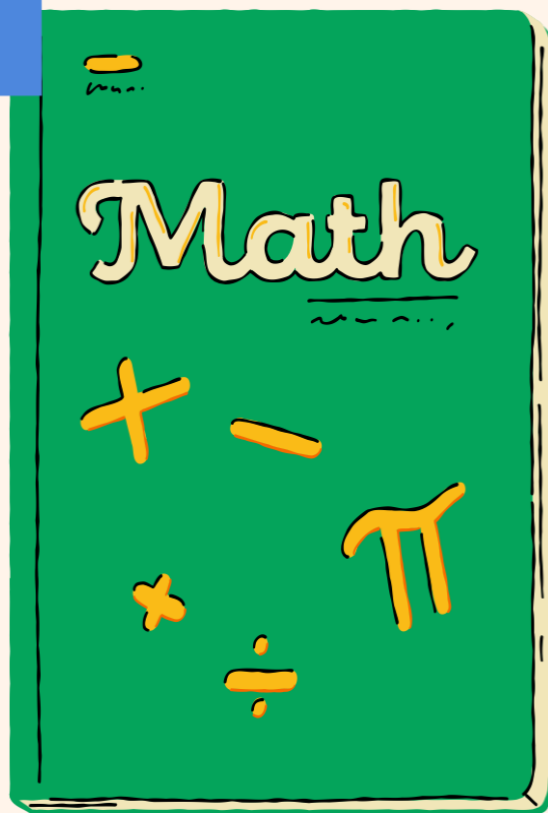

Go outside and look for different animals and plants (flowers, trees, birds, etc.).

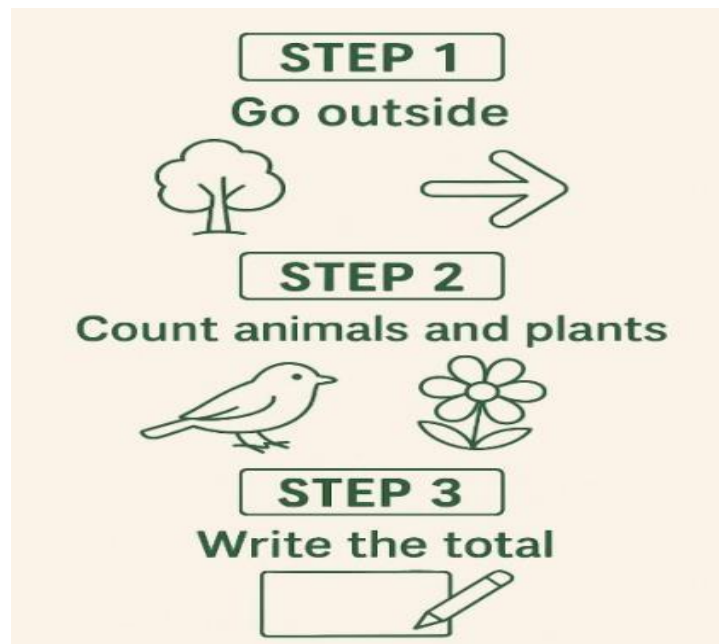
Count how many animals and plants you can find.

1. Plant a Small Plant

- Use a recycled container like a pot or an old plastic bottle.
- Add soil and plant a small seed or seedling.
- Ask an adult to help you with planting safely.



2. Care for Your Plant

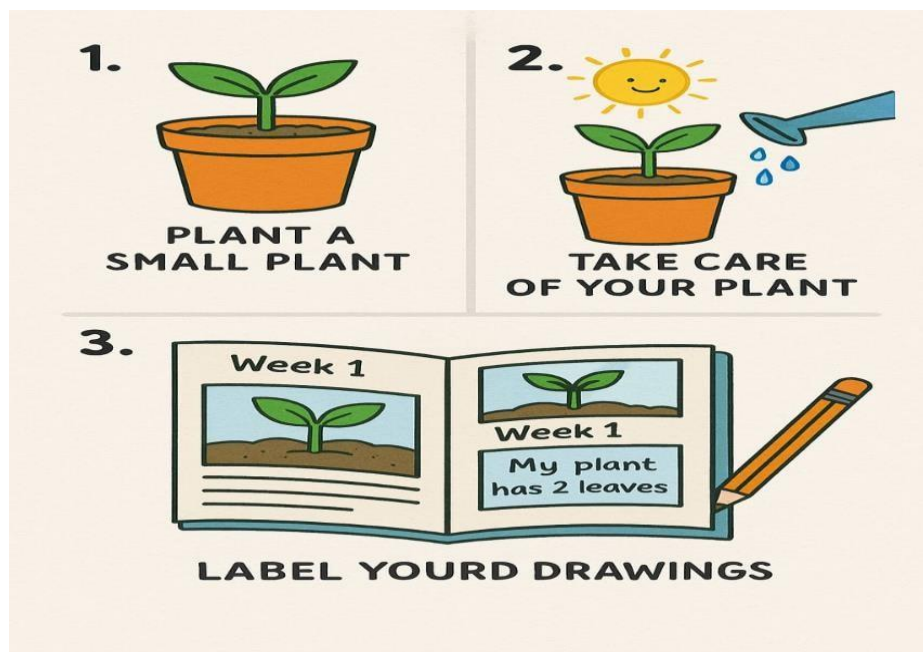
- Place it where it can get sunlight.
- Water it gently when the soil is dry.
- Talk to your plant – care and kindness help it grow!

3. Watch It Grow!

- Observe your plant every week.
- Draw a picture of your plant in a notebook or drawing book.

4. Label Your Drawings

- Write the week number (e.g., Week 1, Week 2).
- Add a short sentence: Example: My plant has two leaves or It grew taller!

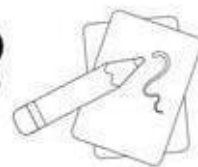

Draw a House Scene

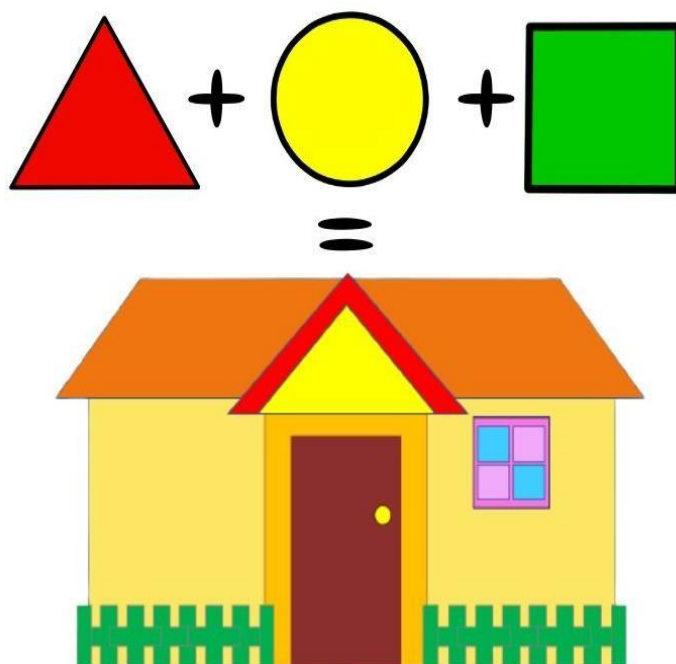
- Use shapes like **rectangle** (house), **triangle** (roof), **Circle** (sun), and **line** (tree trunk).

Materials Required:

- An empty plastic bottle (any size)
- Cardboard or clay (for wings, tail, and beak)
- Acrylic or poster colors (green, red, yellow, etc.)
- Fevicol or glue
- Scissors (use under adult supervision)
- Googly eyes or white & black paper for eyes
- Paint brushes
- Old newspaper (to avoid mess)
- Optional: glitter, colored paper, feathers
