STUDENT GUIDELINES

To ensure the safety, discipline and well-being of all participants during the Educational Tour, parents and students are requested to carefully read and strictly adhere to the following guidelines throughout the tour :

1. Every student must carry his/her **School Identity Card** throughout the tour.
2. Students shall report to the school at the prescribed reporting time. Late reporting may result in missing the tour and the school shall not be responsible for any inconvenience caused.
3. Students must remain with their designated group and accompanying teachers at all times. They should not leave the group without prior permission.
4. Students are expected to display exemplary behaviour and uphold the dignity and reputation of Vanasthali Public School throughout the tour.
5. Respect towards teachers, fellow students, hotel staff, drivers, guides, local residents and public property is expected at all times.
6. Any act of indiscipline, bullying, vandalism, misbehaviour or violation of school rules will invite strict disciplinary action. In serious cases, the School reserves the right to send the student back at the parent's expense.
7. Students must maintain cleanliness in the coach, hotels, restaurants, tourist attractions and all public places visited during the tour.
8. Students should avoid carrying expensive jewellery, excessive cash or other valuable items. The school shall not be responsible for the loss, theft or damage of any personal belongings.
9. Students must strictly follow the instructions issued by the Tour Coordinator, accompanying teachers, hotel authorities and local guides.

10. Students must observe punctuality for all departures, meals, sightseeing schedules and reporting times.

- Separate accommodation shall be provided for boys and girls.
- In case of any medical emergency, the School shall make every reasonable effort to provide immediate medical assistance.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Registration shall be confirmed only upon submission of the duly completed Consent Form along with the prescribed tour fee.
2. The School reserves the right to cancel or modify the tour itinerary, accommodation, transportation, sightseeing schedule or any other arrangement due to operational requirements, weather conditions, government directives, safety concerns or other unavoidable circumstances.
3. The School shall exercise all reasonable care and necessary precautions to ensure the safety and well-being of the participants throughout the tour.
4. However, the School, its Management, Staff Members, Tour Coordinator, accompanying teachers, transport providers, hotels and associated agencies shall not be held liable for any accident, illness, injury, theft, loss, delay, natural calamity or any unforeseen event beyond their reasonable control.
5. Students shall strictly abide by the rules and instructions issued by the School and the Tour Coordinator throughout the tour.
6. The decision of the School Management and the Tour Coordinator shall be final and binding in all matters relating to the conduct of the Educational Tour.
7. The student must submit a valid **Medical Fitness Certificate** issued by a registered medical practitioner. Submission of the certificate is mandatory for participation in the Educational Tour.

CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

The School makes advance financial commitments towards transportation, hotel reservations, meals, entry tickets, local sightseeing and other logistical arrangements immediately after confirming the bookings. Accordingly, the following policy shall apply:

1. **The tour fee of ₹ 5,700/- per student is strictly NON-REFUNDABLE.**
2. **Once the registration is confirmed and the tour fee is deposited, no refund, either full or partial, shall be made under any circumstances whatsoever.** This includes, but is not limited to:
 - Withdrawal by the student or parent after registration.
 - Illness, injury or any medical condition.
 - Personal or family emergencies.
 - Coaching classes or any other personal academic commitments.
 - Change of mind after registration.
 - Failure to report at the scheduled reporting or departure time.
 - Cancellation by the participant for any reason whatsoever.
3. As the School incurs non-refundable commitments with hotels, transport providers and other service partners well in advance, **requests for cancellation, transfer of registration, adjustment of fees or refund shall not be entertained under any circumstances.**
4. In the event of any modification to the itinerary, accommodation, travel schedule, sightseeing programme or other arrangements due to weather conditions, traffic restrictions, government directives, operational requirements, force majeure events or any unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the School, every reasonable effort shall be made to provide suitable alternatives. Such changes shall **not** entitle any participant to claim any refund, compensation, damages or reimbursement.
5. Submission of the Registration Form, Consent Form and payment of the tour fee shall constitute the parent/guardian's unconditional acceptance of this Cancellation & Refund Policy.
